Mila Fürstová, born in Czechoslovakia and living and working in the UK, creates delicate ethereal etchings, pursuing an age-old technique in a contemporary context. Described as a storyteller and an alchemist of form, Fürstová's dazzling images are both contemporary and personal, searching in the surreality of dreams, tales and fables that can map the framework of our consciousness.

Whilst referencing history, culture and mythology, she cuts, folds and overlays her works, often printing on glass or other transparent surfaces, and thus creates imagery that is multidimensional in terms of both form and meaning. The initial image undergoes metamorphosis as the alchemical process of etching progresses through each of its stages.

Mila Fürstová, is an award winning internationally exhibited artist, who has shown in 20 solo shows in many countries including Britain, USA, France and the Czech Republic over the last decade. During this time she has won 14 prestigious awards. Her work has become part of important private and public collections, including that of Queen Elizabeth II and the V&A Museum in London and has featured in numerous publications.
